## 1. Open Finder, click on Go --> Go to folder



2. A popup window will appear type:

/Users/TYPE\_YOUR\_CURRENT\_MAC\_USER\_HERE/.ChaosGroup inside and press the Go button. To see the user you are currently logged in on your Mac (the one you need to type above), go to System preferences -->Users & Groups.
